RULES AND REGULATIONS COVERING DISCHARGE INTO SYSTEM

Sewer Code, Division XI. Discharge of Waste to the Public Sewer, Section 11.01 Waste Disposal Permit Required:

No person shall discharge, or cause to be discharged, any industrial waste into the District sanitary sewer system without having obtained an Industrial Waste Permit from T-TSA. Such permit is required in addition to any other permits that may be required by the District Code, County Code, State Stature or other Ordinance, rule or regulation applicable to the industrial discharge.

A person discharging waste into a public sewer shall obtain a permit from the District prior to discharge.

The District shall not grant such a permit unless it finds that sufficient capacity exists in the public sewer to allow for such waste.

For the purpose of this Section, garbage grinders powered by motors of more than one horsepower and grease interceptors installed in restaurants are considered to be industrial waste facilities.

Per Schedule A of the Olympic Valley Public Service District Sewer Code, to follow are the fees required for the above project.
