

Fuels Management:

<u>OV-4 Ph. 1:</u> Work has been completed along Everline/Resort Road, the area behind 7-11. High Sierra is currently working in the Homesites HOA area.
<u>OV-4 Ph. 2:</u> Implementation should be completed by the end of this summer.
<u>OV-2:</u> Bid is being prepared and right-of-entry agreements are being secured.
Contract award is planned for July or August. Implementation to begin this fall or next summer with work scheduled to be completed by November 2026.
<u>OV-3:</u> Staff are working with Crosscheck Services to finalize the bid price, contract and encroachment permit. Work anticipates this fall.
<u>OV-5:</u> Staff have met with potential funding agencies to discuss the project. Staff are working to secure funding for the project planning and implementation.
