<u>OV-3</u>: Staff are working with Crosscheck Services to finalize the contract and encroachment permit. Work is anticipated this fall.

OV-5: Staff have met with potential funding agencies to discuss the project. Staff are applying funding from the CAL FIRE Wildfire Prevention Grant for the project planning and implementation.




