Staffing and Employment:

Fuels Management:

OV-4 Ph. 1: High Sierra has completed all work in southern and eastern parts of the Valley and roughly 50% complete with work in western end.

<u>OV-4 Ph. 2:</u> Implementation expected later this summer with completion by the end of the season. In anticipation of fall pile burning, staff are revisiting contracts and communicating with property owners.

<u>OV-2</u>: Right-of-entry agreements have been secured and bid planned for this fall. Implementation to begin next summer with completion by next winter.

<u>OV-3</u>: Staff have submitted a contract to Crosscheck Services. Work is anticipated this fall.

<u>OV-5:</u> Staff have applied for funding from the CAL FIRE Wildfire Prevention Grant for the project planning and implementation.

<u>CWPP Update:</u> Staff have applied for funding from the CAL FIRE Wildfire Prevention Grant for the project.




