NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE 2025-03 ADOPTING AND AMENDING THE 2025 FIRE CODE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Directors of the Olympic Valley Public Service District (OVPSD) of Placer County is considering the adoption of an ordinance that would amend and adopt the 2025 California Fire Code. A public hearing on this matter will be held to review, explain, and allow for public input on the intended revisions.

A certified copy of the 2025 California Fire Code, the proposed amendments thereto, and the proposed Ordinance amending and adopting the 2025 California Fire Code are on file with the Board Secretary and are open to public inspection and are available on the District's website. For additional information contact the District at 530-583-4692.

The proposed changes to the Fire Prevention Code are mostly technical in nature, changing how the Code references the California Fire and Building Codes as well as the NFPA Standards. The regulations allow for a higher safety standard for climatic, geologic and topographical factors in our District. The revisions proposed at this time correct and update references to California Codes, remove obsolete Fire Prevention Code sections, revise language to clarify the intent of the Fire Prevention Code and revise language to amendments and adoptions specific to our local climatic, geological, or topographical conditions (using language consistent with that adopted by all the fire departments in the region).

IF YOU WISH TO BE HEARD ON THIS MATTER, a public hearing will be held at the time and place described above. Public comments will be accepted by the Board and should be submitted to the Board Secretary at info@ovpsd.org, by mail at P.O. Box 2026, Olympic Valley, California 96146 (the final mail collection prior to the meeting will be the day before the meeting at 2:00 p.m.), and in-person at the public hearing until the close of public comment on the item.
