- Working on comprehensive financial analysis

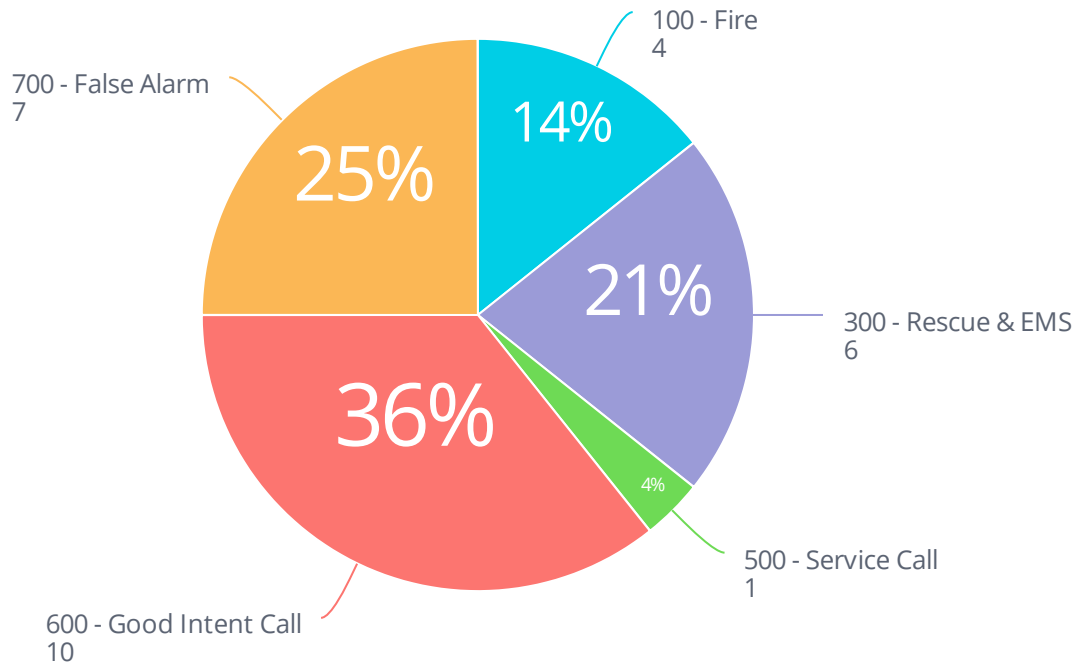

Call volume by incident type group



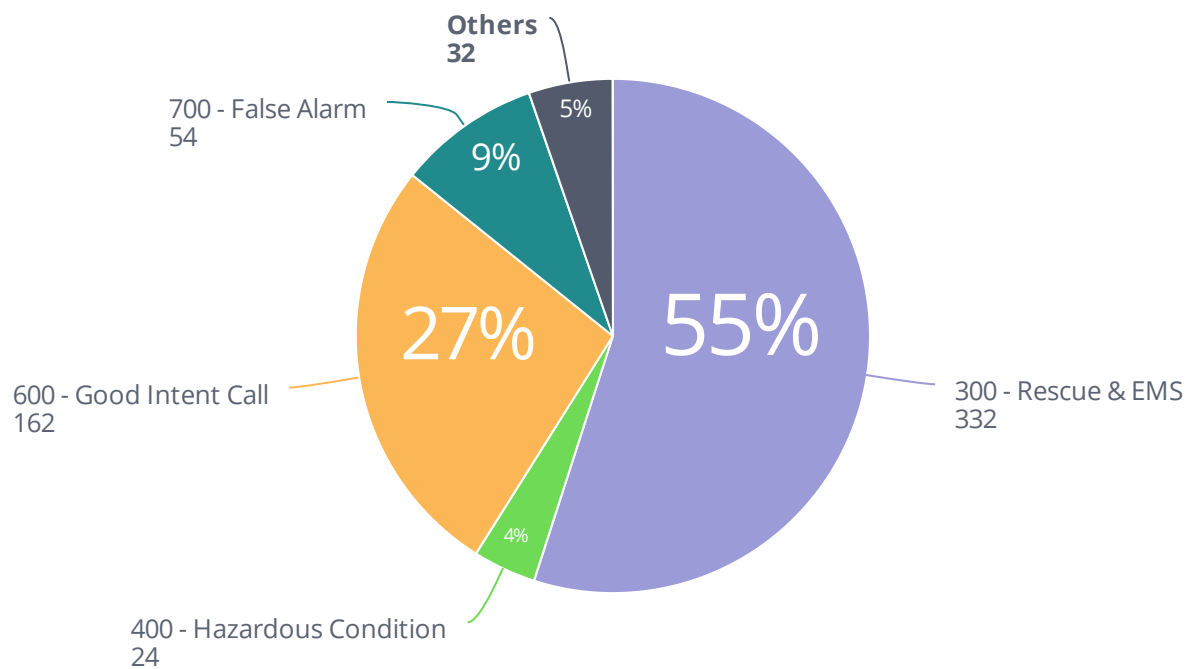
