Fuels Management:

OV-2: Project implementation is expected to begin in August 2026. Staff are working with Cross Check Services to ensure all contractual obligations are met, coordinating with Feather River Forestry to prepare the project for implementation, and providing outreach and communication to affected property owners and homeowners associations regarding the project.

OV-5: The project is under contract, with roadwork improvements anticipated to begin construction this fall and forestry operations planned for 2027.

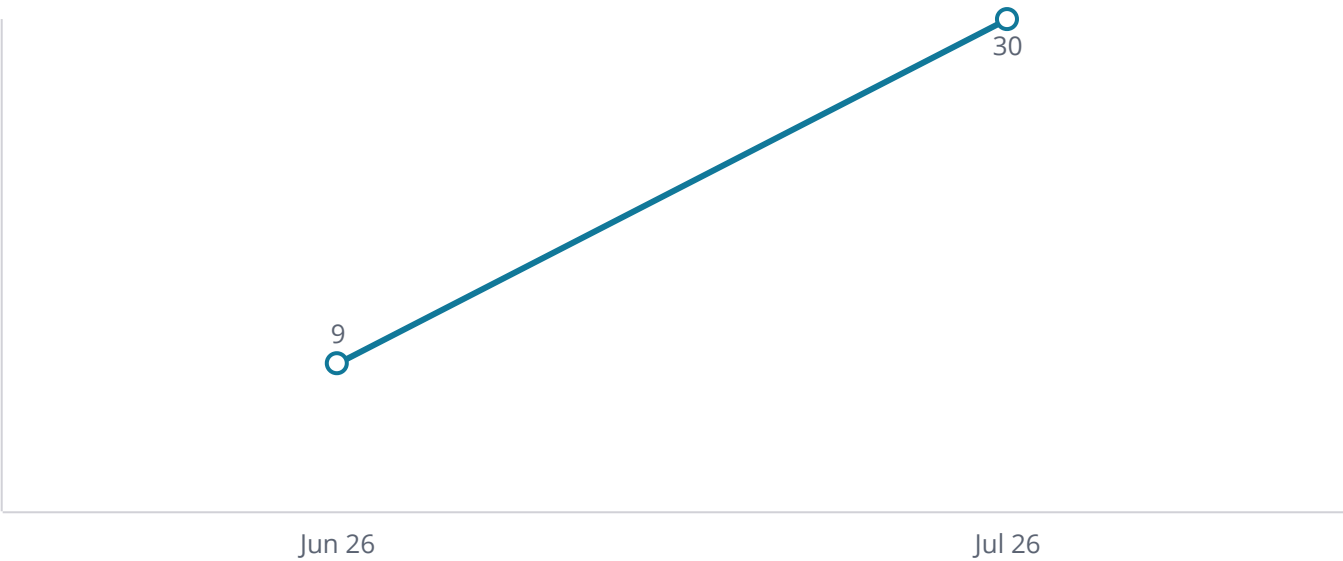

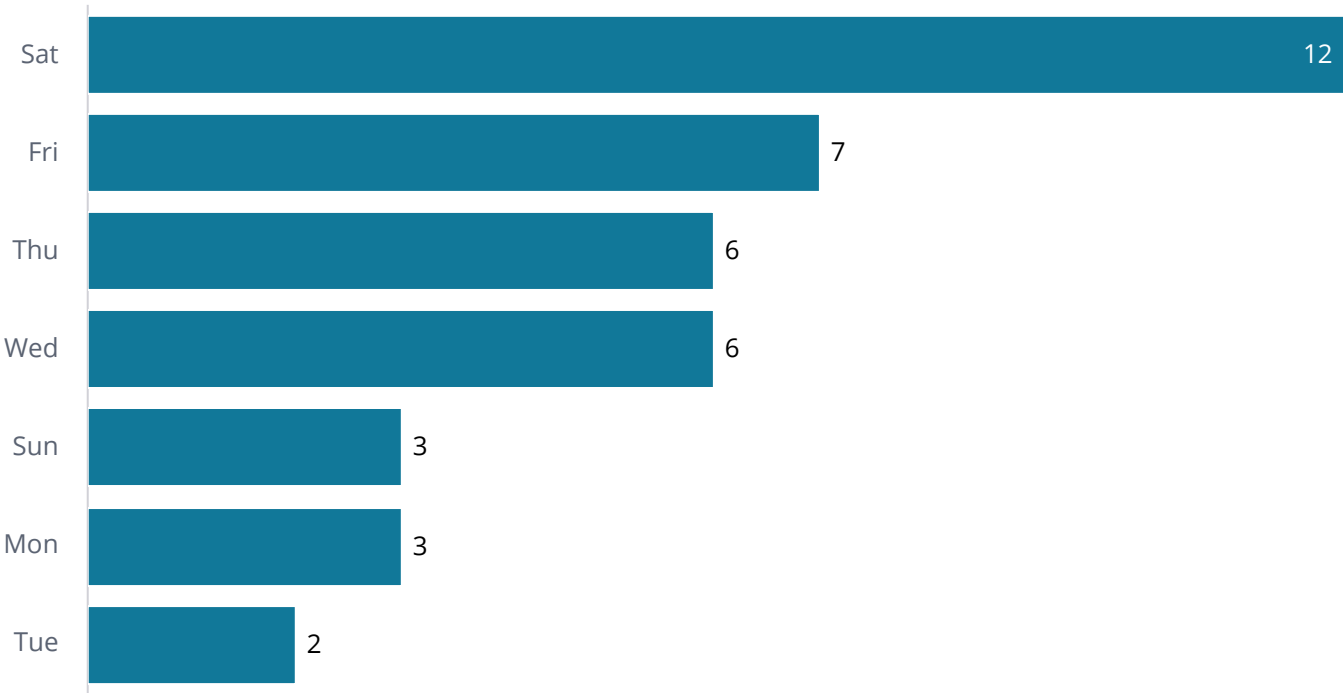

Incident Count by Day of Week

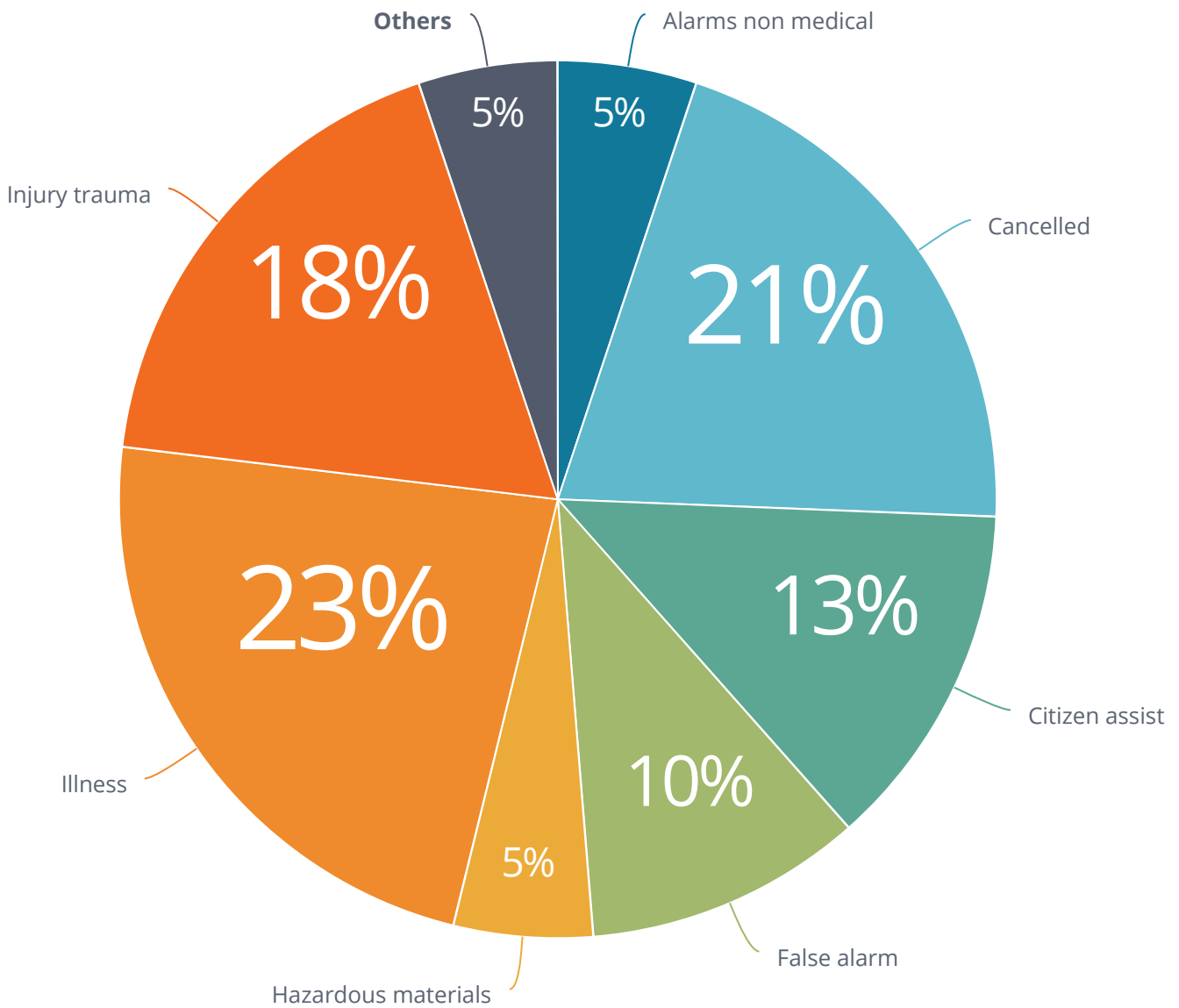

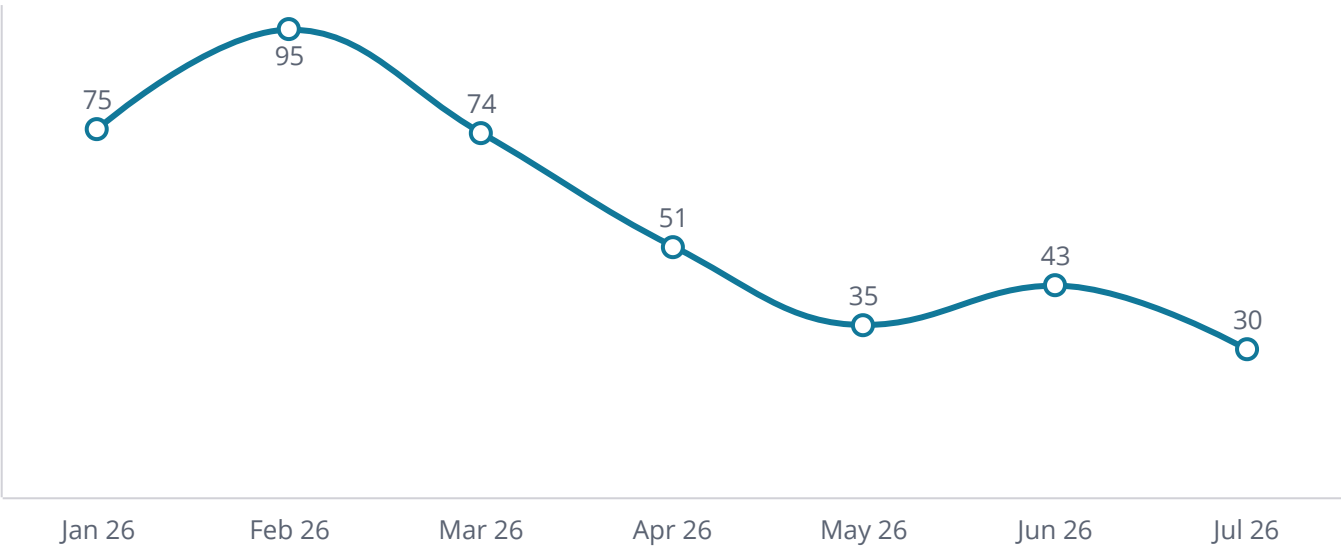

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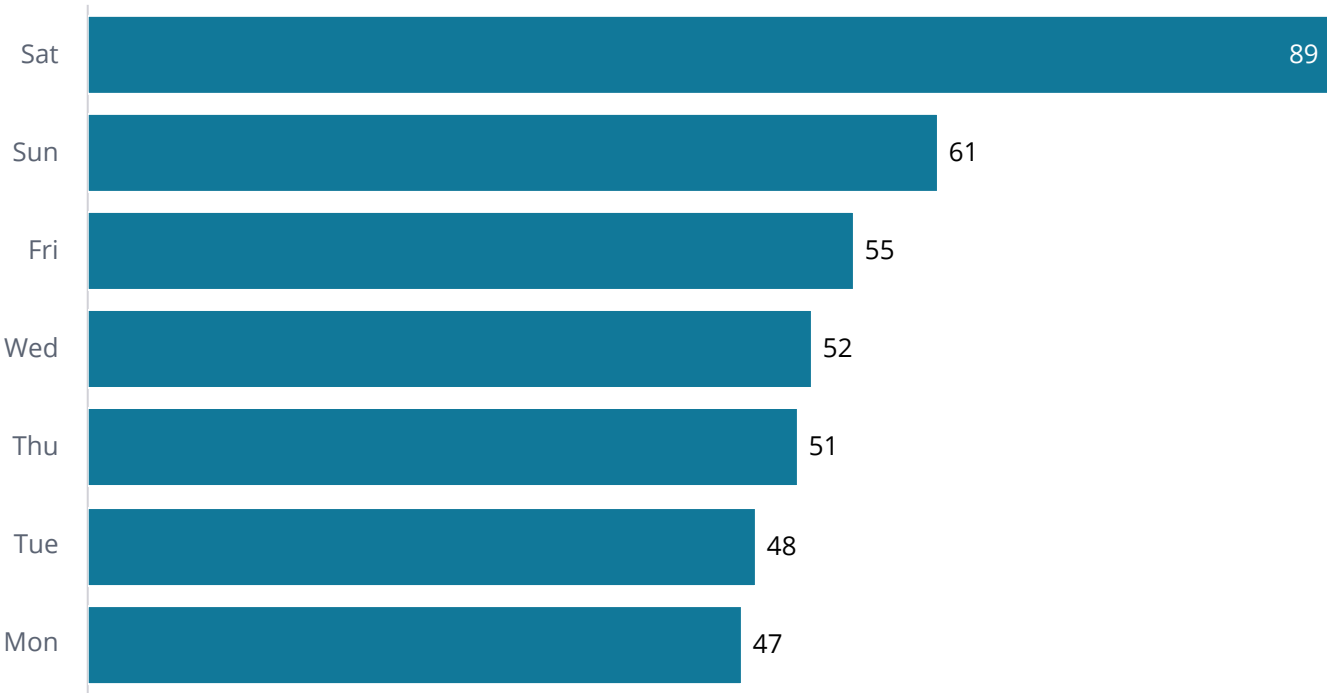
