AB 1383 – Public Employees' Retirement Benefits:

Staff is monitoring AB 1383, proposed legislation that would make several changes to public employee retirement benefits, including increasing the PEPPRA compensation cap for all employees and modifying retirement provisions for public safety employees. While the legislation has the potential to affect employer pension costs, the impact on individual agencies will vary. Staff has completed a preliminary review of the bill and will provide the Board with a brief update on the proposed legislation and its potential relevance to the District.
