Fuels Management:

OV-2: Because the necessary/specialized equipment is still not available to complete OV-2 this season, Cross Check has requested to switch the order of the projects and proceed with OV-5 this year, with OV-2 to follow next year.

OV-5: With the change to OV-2, OV-5 is now anticipated to begin with roadway improvements and access preparation, followed by forestry operations. Work will begin once final CAL FIRE permitting is received, with a start date anticipated in late August or early September and continue through the fall, as conditions permit.

We have coordinated these changes with Danielle Bradfield, TTAD, and Placer County, and have communicated the revised schedule to the affected property owners. We still anticipate completing both projects by the end of 2027.

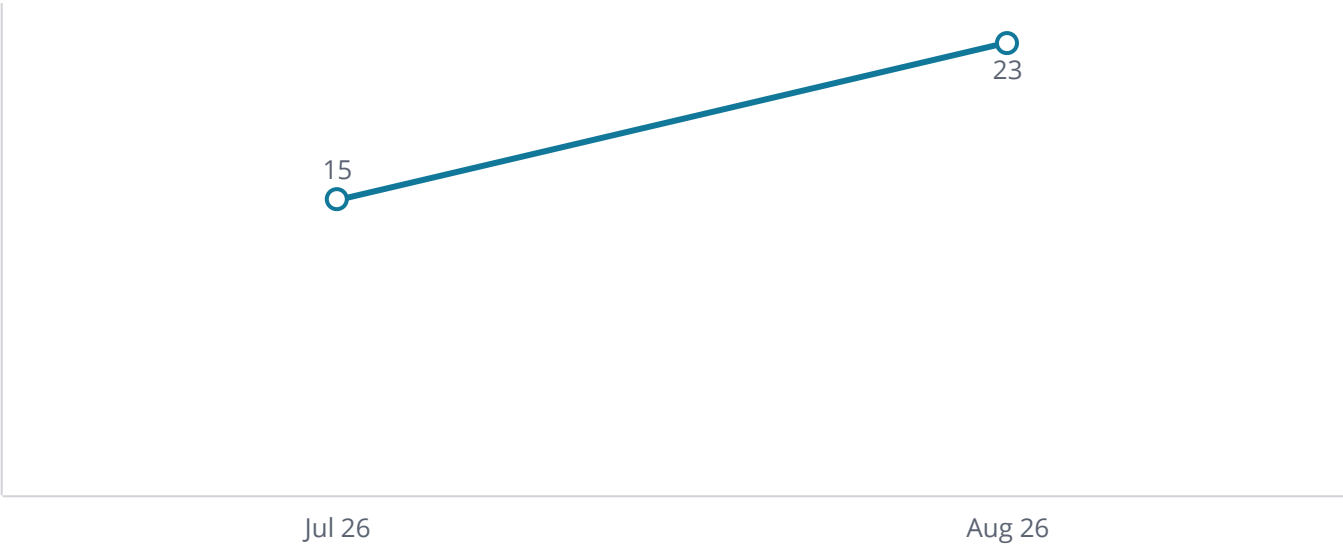

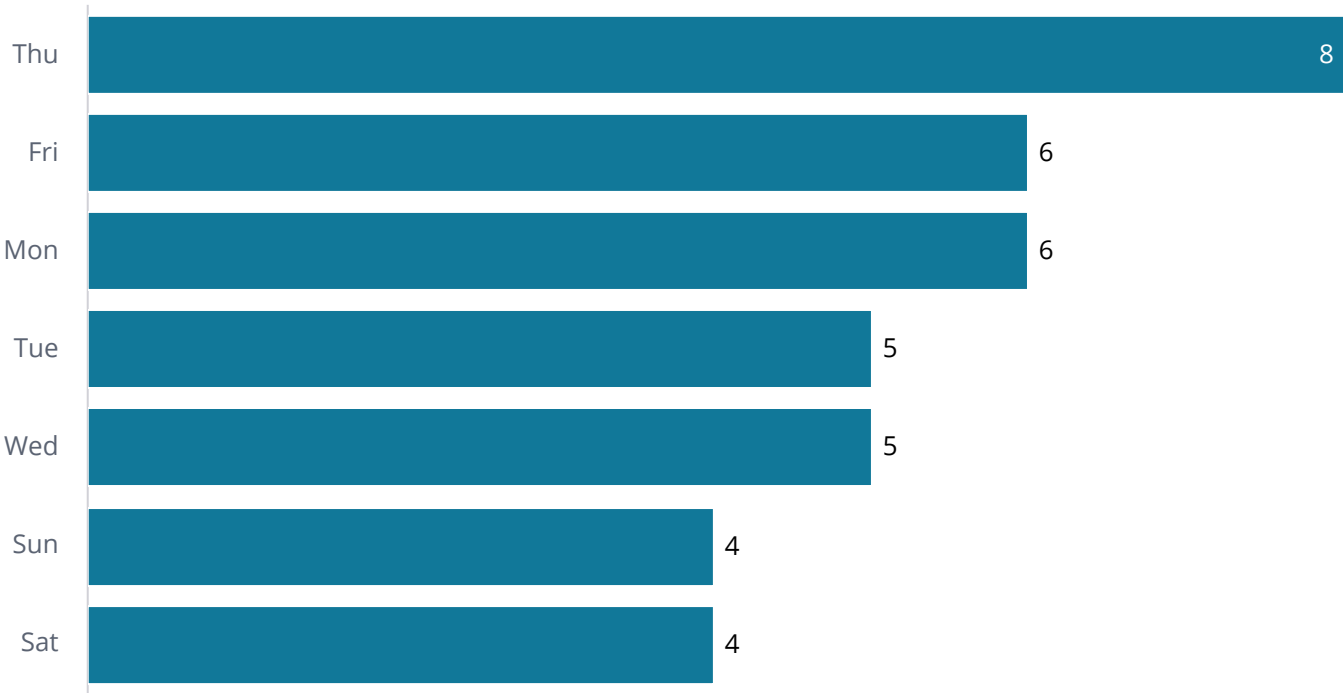

Incident Count By Month (This Year)



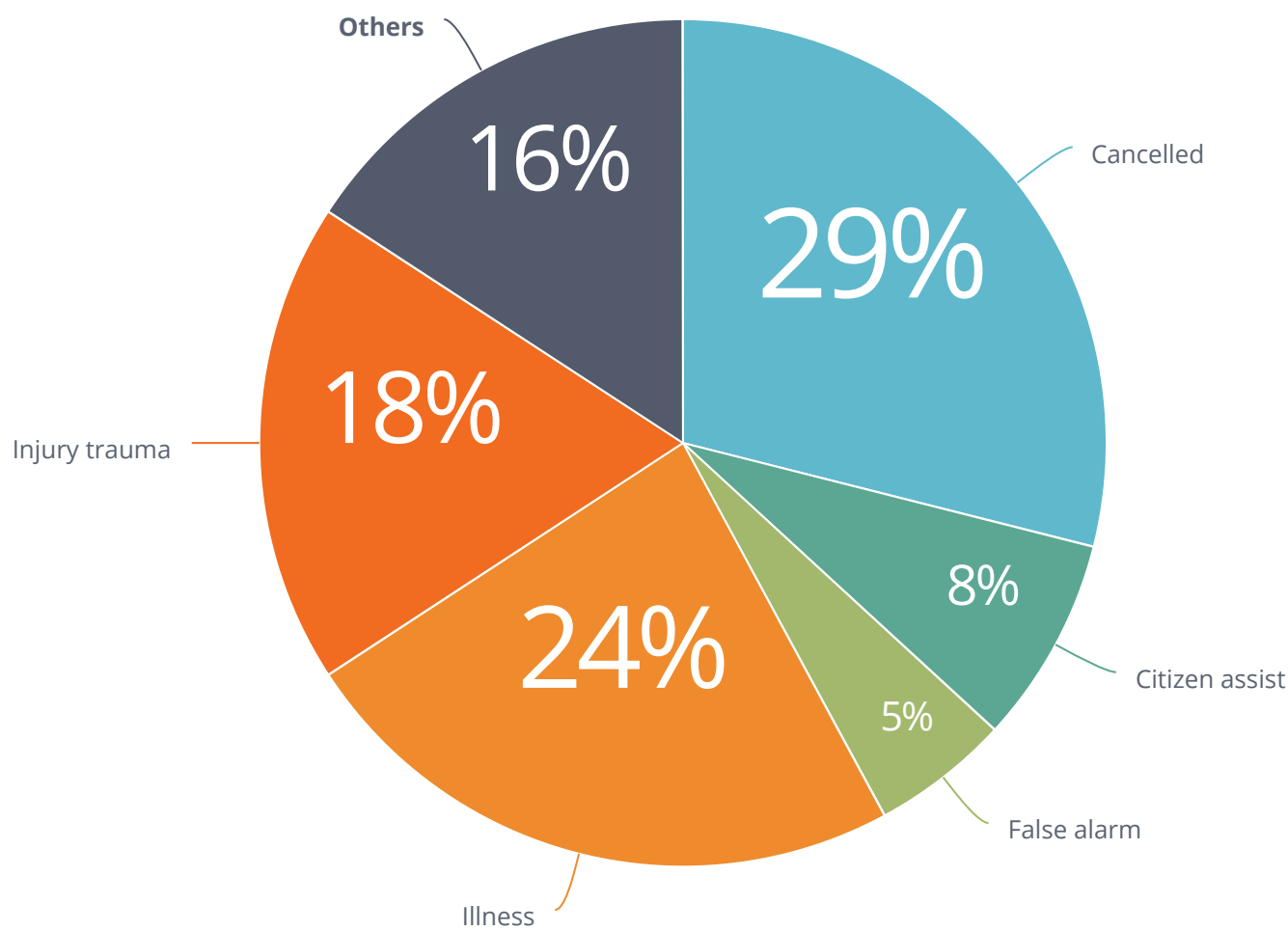

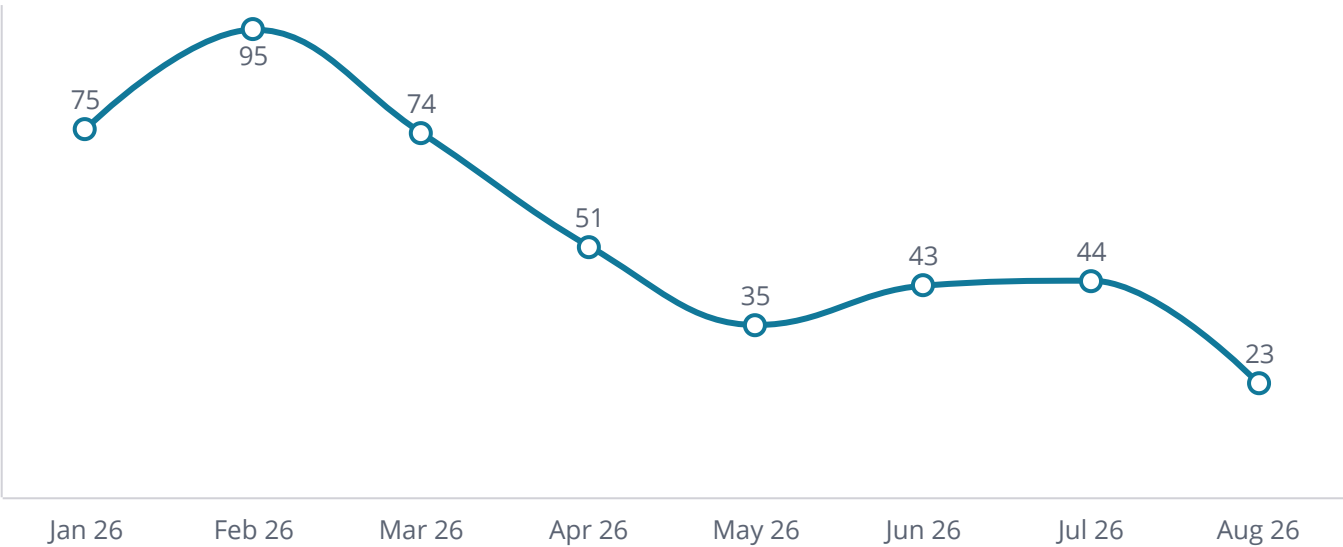

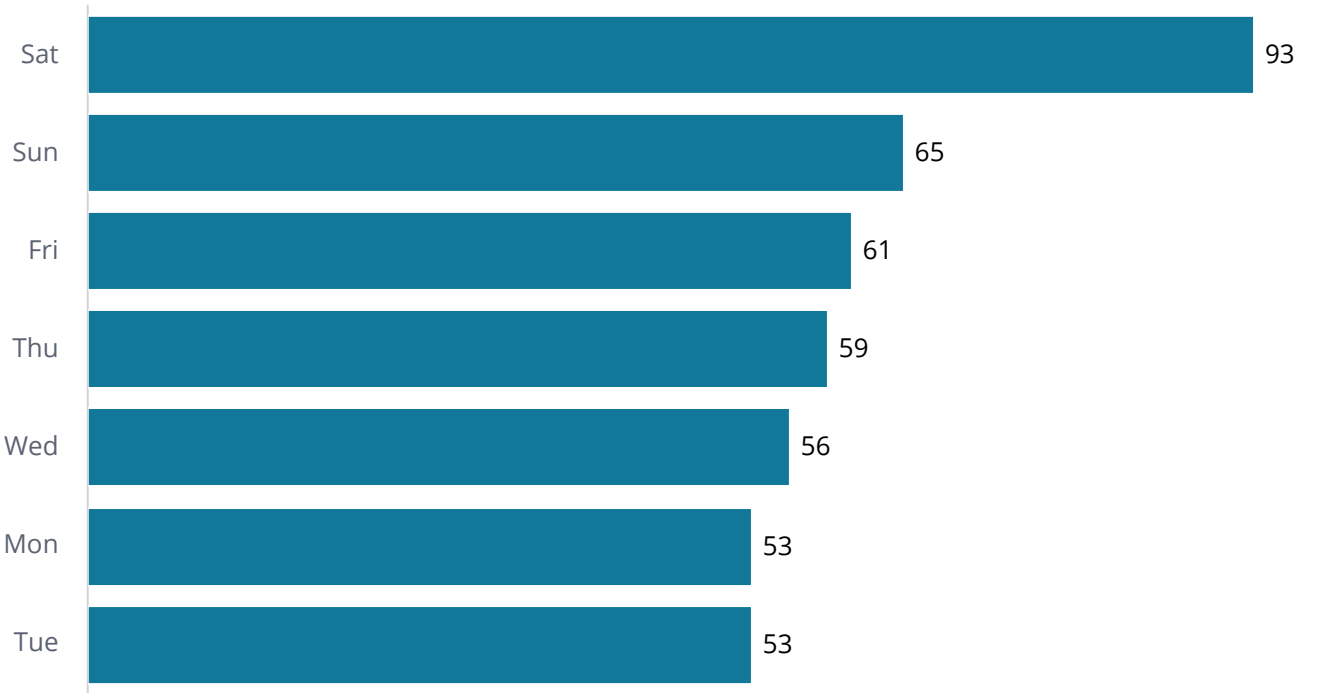
